Cities Most Affected:

1. Houston

 As the largest city in Harris County and the project hub, Houston will be significantly impacted by the <u>HyVelocity</u> Hydrogen Hub.

2. Pasadena

 Located within Harris County, Pasadena will be affected due to its proximity to industrial zones and the Houston Ship Channel.

3. Baytown

 Also in Harris County, Baytown is close to major industrial and petrochemical complexes.

4. Sugar Land

 In Fort Bend County, Sugar Land will experience impacts due to its economic and industrial growth.

5. Pearland

 Situated in Brazoria County, Pearland is part of the Greater Houston metropolitan area and will be impacted by regional developments.

6. Galveston

 Located in Galveston County, the city will be affected due to its port facilities and industrial activities.

7. Corpus Christi

 As a major port city and industrial hub, Corpus Christi is heavily involved in energy production and distribution. The city's infrastructure, workforce, and strategic location on the Gulf of Mexico make it a key player in the <u>HyVelocity</u> Hydrogen Hub project.

8. The Woodlands

 In Montgomery County, The Woodlands will be impacted as part of the broader metropolitan area.
